Residents - Reg:

Ref:- Your letter No.B2/16422/2009/DME dated 18.11.2009.

I am to invite your attention to the reference cited and to inform you that the PG Medical students may be granted leave on medical ground upto 30 days only if the same is recommended by the concerned HOD and the leave application beyond 30 days shall be referred to Medical Board and it shall be granted only if the same is recommended by the Medical Board.

You are also informed that Government have revised the stipend of Residents w.e.f. 01.01.2009. Hence all students doing the course now ie., extension or otherwise are eligible for new rate of stipend.

It is also clarified that the students are not eligible for stipend during the period of leave and the period of extension if they avail leave beyond a period of 20 days casual leave and 15 days special leave already admissible other than on medical certificates.
