Guide lines for starting practical classes for Paramedical Courses

- 1. All the colleges are informed to start (only) the practical classes by 15th January 2021 and the total number of students at a stretch in a class should be limited to maximum 25 in number. Hence 2 to 3 batches can be scheduled for class of fortnight, giving overtime hours and including holidays, Saturdays and Sundays, inorder to avoid crowding. Theory classes should be continued on line. The priority shall be given to the exam going batch.
- 2. All Students tested negative by RTPCR report (within two days) can report for rejoining .
- 3. If a student is tested positive, the student should inform the concerned representative and he/she must undergo isolation complying Govt Covid Protocol.
- 4. At the time of re-joining the college and hostels and they must be re-called in batches and they should be given proper awareness on practising Safe Physical distancing: Physical distancing of at least (approximately) 6 feet to be followed.
- 5. All the colleges are hereby informed to constitute Corona Jagratha Samithis for each batch consisting of PTA members, Faculty representatives, Students representative and wardens for proper monitoring and effective implementation of the preventive measures taken.
- 6. An affidavit for complying with the Covid Protocol in the campus in the prescribed format duly signed by the parent shall be submitted at the time of admission to the college.
- 7. Practical training and posting of supervisory staff are to be done avoiding crowding in labs/clinics/wards strictly complying the Covid Protocol.
