ORDER

Government, as per Order read as 1st paper above, issued Prospectus for admission to B.Sc. Nursing Course for the Academic Year 2024-25. As per G.O read as 2nd paper above, sanction was accorded to the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology for making allotment to the B.Sc Nursing course seats in Government colleges, colleges under Government controlled educational institutions viz. State Institute of Medical Education & Technology, Centre for Professional & Advanced Studies, Co-operative Academy of Professional Education and Malabar Cancer Centre and the Government merit seats in 114 private self financing colleges. As per G.O read as 4th paper above sanction was

accorded to the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology for making allotment to the B.Sc Nursing course seats of remaining 5 Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges and to the enhanced number of seats in 15 Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges.

2. Vide order read as 4th paper above, Hon'ble High Court of Kerala has ordered to restore the number of seats in Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing, Perumbavoor to 60 and directed the Kerala University of Health Sciences to issue provisional affiliation to the college for the academic year 2024-25 fixing the number of seats as 60. Vide letter read as 4th paper above, Director of Medical Education has reported that the KUHS has restored the number of seats in CPAS Institute of Nursing Education, School of Medical Education, Chuttipara, Pathanamthitta to 50.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail. In compliance with the Order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.P (C) No. 29567/2024 dated 23.08.2024, number of seats in Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing, Perumbavoor is enhanced to 60 from 40. In the light of the report of DME read as 3rd paper above, number of seats in CPAS Institute of Nursing Education, School of Medical Education, Chuttipara, Pathanamthitta is enhanced to 50 from 30.

4. Under the circumstance, Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology is directed to make allotment to 30 Government merit seats in Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing, Perumbavoor and to the 20 enhanced number of seats in CPAS Institute of Nursing Education, School of Medical Education, Chuttipara, Pathanamthitta, considering the same as Government merit seats.
