ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the Implementation of AARDRAM Project (OPD Transformation) for eight Medical Colleges under the Directorate of Medical Education at total cost of Rs.5181.84 Lakh by meeting the expenditure from the H/A 2210-06-101-16 (P). During the FY 2018-19, Administrative Sanction was also accorded for an amount of Rs.997 Lakh under the H/A 2210-01-110 (P) for OPD transformation under the AARDRAM Project vide Government Order read as 4th paper above.

2. A total amount of Rs.2289 Lakh has been released to NHM during the FY 2016-17 (Rs.1292 L) & 2018-19 (Rs.997 L) for the execution of works under the project. As per the letter read as 5th paper above, the

Director of Medical Education has informed that, a total amount of Rs.938.63786 Lakh is pending towards NHM for AARDRAM related activities and for settling final bills of the works to the contractors and therefore requested to release the amount urgently to the NHM.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to release an amount of Rs.4,69,31,893/- (50% of Rs. 9,38,63,786/-) (Rupees Four Crore Sixty Nine Lakh Thirty One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety Three Only) from the provision available under the H/A "2210-01-110-10-Creation of Patient Friendly Hospital Environment" (DME) in the current years Budget for settling the final bills of AARDRAM Mission. Sanction is also accorded for transfer crediting the fund to the National Health Mission.

In this connection, the Director of Medical Education should ensure the following for further release of funds:

i Government does not incur any financial loss by the delay occurred in completing the works.

ii. In the case of works which were tendered before bifurcating GST from the value of work the contractor is not eligible for additional 12% GST. Hence Director of Medical Education should also ensure that additional 12% GST has not been paid to the contractors which are tendered before bifurcating GST.
