ORDER

As per the Kerala Co-operative Hospital Complex, the Academy of Medical Sciences and Allied Institutions (Taking over and Administration) Act, 2019 (ACT 13 OF 2019), the Co-operative Hospital Complex, the Academy of Medical Sciences and allied institutions in Pariyaram, Kannur District, managed by the Board of Control appointed by the Government were taken over and administered by the Government of Kerala with effect from 2nd day of March, 2019.As per the GO read as 1 st paper above, Government had created 11 administrative posts including the Principal of the institution. As per the GO read as 2nd

paper above, Kerala Co-operative Hospital and Centre for Advanced Medical Services (K.C.H.C), Pariyaram Medical College, Pariyaram Dental College, Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pariyaram College of Nursing, Pariyaram School of Nursing, Sahakarana Hridayalaya, Institute of Para Medical Sciences were brought under the administrative control of the Medical Education Department. As per the GO read as 3rd paper above, 772 post were created for the accommodation of the regular medical faculties of erstwhile Pariyaram Medical College. Out of the 772 posts, 26 posts were strictly earmarked for the accommodation of the regular Pharmacy faculties of erstwhile Pariyaram Medical College. As per the GO read 6th paper above, Government have approved the department wise split up of the aforesaid 26 posts created for the accommodation of the Pharmacy faculties with 5 Associate Professor and 21 Assistant Professor posts. Out of which 7 Assistant Professor posts were created on supernumerary basis. Subsequently, on the basis of the proposal furnished by the DME, Government have issued orders for the accommodation of 26 Pharmacy Faculties of erstwhile ACME Pariyaram to the Government Medical College, Kannur with effect from 02/03/2019 as per the GO read as 7th paper above. Later on, as per the GO read as 8th paper above, the above mentioned 7 supernumerary posts were re-designated as vanishing posts, with the conditions that these posts would be completely eliminated upon retirement, promotion, death, or dismissal of the incumbent.

2) In the the high level meeting held on 07.10.2021, it was decided to called for option from the accommodated employees either to be “stand alone” or to be “the entry cadre "category of Government service whichever is suited for them. As per the letter read as 5th paper above, Government have approved the option form of the accommodated employees. The Principal, Government Medical College, Kannur has submitted the duly filled option forms from the regular pharmacy faculties which has been received in Government through the Director of Medical Education as per the letter 9th cited.

3) In the circumstances, by accepting the duly filled option form submitted by the regular pharmacy faculties, the persons included in the table below are appointed temporarily under Rule 9 (a) (i) of KS&SSR as Assistant Professor subject to conditions laid down in the Kerala Co-operative Hospital Complex, the Academy of Medical Sciences and Allied Institutions (Taking over and Administration) Act, 2019 (ACT 13 OF 2019) and subsequent orders and decisions taken in this regard.

4) The regularization of the appointment will be subject to the verification of the character and antecedents of the incumbents through Police verification as stipulated in GO(P)No. 112/2006/Home dated 31/07/2006 and GO(P)No.79/2009/Home dated 05/06/2009.

5) The appointment shall be terminated without notice if found on such verification that character and antecedents are not satisfactory and also that there was any misrepresentation or suppression of material facts on the part of the incumbent.

6) The Principal, Government Medical College, Kannur is directed to issue necessary orders permitting them to join duty and also take urgent necessary steps as per the usual terms and conditions of the appointment in this regard.
