ORDER

As per Government Order read as paper (1), Government have enhanced monthly stipend of the Bonded Lecturers from ₹18,500/- to ₹20,500/- and permission was granted to engage 80 candidates, who have successfully completed M.Sc. (N) during the Academic Year 2022-23, as Bonded Lecturers. Later, Government accorded sanction to engage candidates, who have successfully completed M.Sc (N) and having KNMC registration irrespective of the year of passing out, as Bonded Lecturers to fulfill the required strength for the Academic Year 2023-24, as per order read as paper (2), since only a small section of eligible students who have successfully completed M.Sc. (N) during the Academic Year 2022-23 were willing to serve as Bonded Lecturers.

2. Now, the Director of Medical Education as per letter read as paper (3) has reported that 40 teaching posts still remains vacant and hence requested to permit the Director to engage those candidates, who have successfully completed M.Sc. (N) from both Government and private self financing nursing colleges and having KNMC registration, so as to maintain the teacher - student ratio so that the deficiency in faculty in Government Nursing Colleges in Kerala, pointed by Kerala

University of Health Sciences, Thrissur can be rectified.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to engage candidates, who have successfully completed M.Sc (N) from both Government colleges and private self financing nursing colleges and having KNMC registration, irrespective of the year of passing out, as Bonded Lecturers to fulfill the required strength for the Academic Year 2023-24.
