ORDER

The establishment of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) is a long standing needs for the development of Health Sector in the State. The State Government had identified the land at Kinaloor in Kozhikode District suitable for establishing All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala and the same was communicated to Government of India as per the letter read as 1st paper above. Subsequently,on the basis of the decision taken in the meeting held on 20/09/2021 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister ,the following directions have been issued in connection with the establishment of AIIMS as per the GO read as 3rd paper above .

- a. The Industries Department shall allot maximum extent of land available with MD KSIDC in Kinaloor and adjoining Village in the name of DME for the purpose.
- b.The Revenue Department shall initiate proceedings for acquisition of nearby land as reported by the District Collector Kozhikkode .
- c.The Finance Department shall do allotment of amount for doing land acquisition for establishing AIIMS.
- d.The District Collector Kozhikkode shall issue notification for the land

acquisition and take follow up actions for the land acquisition.

2) Subsequently, as per the GO read as 4th paper above, the Industries Department have accorded sanction to the Managing Director, Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation Ltd (KSIDC Ltd) for dispossession & handed over of 142.678 acres of unutilized land owned by KSIDC at Industrial Growth center at Kinaloor and Kanthalad Villages in Kozhikkode District to Revenue Department for transferring the same to Health & Family Welfare Department for setting up of AIIMS in the State subject to the condition that the land shall not be used for other purposes.

3) In the letter read as 5th paper above, the Director of Medical Education has informed that no special head of account or amount has been sanctioned for incurring the costs associated with the establishment of AIIMS in Kerala and has requested to approve the proposal submitted by the Special Tahsildar, Land Acquisition, Koyilandy and also requested to sanction an amount of Rs.92,61,937/(Ninety Two lakhs Sixty one Thousand Nine hundred and Thirty seven rupees only) towards contingency charges under the H/A 2210-05-001- 99-34-03 OC (Non plan) of the DME or any other suitable Head of Account for the purpose.

4) Subsequently, as per the GO read as 6th paper above, sanction was accorded to open a new Head of Account, viz '4210-03-105-13 (PV)' with the Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department (CCO Code -280B) as Chief Controlling Officer for meeting the expenses towards the land acquisition for the setting up of 'All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala'. As per the GO read as 7th paper above, an amount of Rs.92,62,000/- has been authorized under the H/A '4210- 03-105-13 (PV)' for meeting the expenses towards the land acquisition for setting up of 'All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala'.

5) In the Letter read as 8th paper above, the DME has reported that the Special Tahsildar, Koyilandy has informed that an amount Rs. 50 lakh (maximum amount as per LA Act) is sufficient for land acquisition and has requested to remit the said amount to the work deposit head of Special Tahsildar urgently. The DME has also requested to sanction an amount of Rs 50 lakh towards contingency charges for land acquisition in connection with the establishment of AIIMS.

6) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction to utilize an amount of Rs.50,00,000/- (Fifty lakh Rupees only) from the amount authorized under the Head of Account 4210-03-105-13 (PV) for meeting the expenses towards the land acquisition for setting up of 'All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala'. The balance amount (Rs 42,62,000/-) shall be kept in the Head of Account 4210-03-105-13 (PV) until further orders.

7) The DME shall take necessary action to transfer an amount of Rs 50 lakh to the work deposit head of 8443-00-117-99-00 (DDO code No.160461B021) of Special Tahsildar, Land Acquisition, Koyilandy urgently.
