ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, a No Objection Certificate was issued to KMCT College of Allied Health Sciences, Mukkam, Kozhikode, for conducting the Diploma in Respiratory Technology Course. The institution, as per the letter read as 3rd paper above, submitted an application for a Letter of Permission to start the Diploma in Respiratory Technology Course with 5 seats.

The government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to grant the Letter of Permission to KMCT College of Allied Health Sciences, Mukkam, Kozhikode, for conducting the Diploma in Respiratory Technology Course with 5 seats on conditions that the institution;

a. shall agree to admit students on a 50% merit and 50% management basis, and merit seat students shall be admitted from the respective State merit list prepared by the Director of Medical Education/Director, LBSCentre and management seats by Management based on merit,

b. shall adhere to fees fixed by the Government from time to time, and no amount other than that fixed by the Government shall be levied

from the students admitted to the aforesaid course,

c. shall agree to comply with all conditions specified in the prospectus issued by the Director of Medical Education for each year,

d. shall execute an agreement with the Government in the Health and Family Welfare (K) Department in respect of fees and admissions every year prior to the allotment of students to the Government merit seats and commencement of classes in an academic year and shall adhere to all conditions contained in that Agreement,

e. shall produce a Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs. 5 Lakh for the course, valid for two years, immediately after issuance of the Letter of Permission,

f. shall renew the Bank Guarantee before its expiry,

g. the Letter of Permission will be withdrawn if any of the above conditions are violated, and

h. shall obtain the permission of the Kerala State Allied and Healthcare Council, constituted as per notification read as 2nd paper above, as and when it becomes functional.
