ORDER

The Chairman, Malik Deenar D.MLT Institute, Thalangara, Kasaragod, submitted an application vide paper read as 2nd paper above for NOC to start the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technician (DMLT) Course with requisite fee as stipulated in the Government Order read as Ist paper above. After inspecting the institution, the Director of Medical Education, as per the letter read as 4th paper above, submitted the Inspection Report and reported that overall facilities in the institution are satisfactory to start these courses.

The government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue **NOC to Malik Deenar D.MLT Institute, Thalangara, Kasaragod, to start the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technician (DMLT) Course with 30 seats**, subject to the approval of Kerala State Allied and Healthcare Council constituted vide Government Order read as 3rd paper above when it becomes fully functional and on the condition that :

(a) The institution shall fulfil all the basic infrastructural facilities,

including the building, laboratory, equipment and teaching faculty, as per norms and standards prescribed by the Kerala Paramedical Council for the course.

(b) The institution shall agree to the condition that 50% of the total seats will be filled up from the merit list prepared by the Director of Medical Education/Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology, and the fee for those seats will be based on the rates fixed by the Government from time to time,

(c) The institution shall agree to the condition that 50% of the total seats shall be management seats, which shall be filled by the Management based on merit or eligibility criteria fixed by Kerala Paramedical Council and fees notified by the Government from time to time.

(d) The institution shall execute an agreement with the Government on (b) and (c) above.

(e) On completion of (a) to (d), the institution shall report to the Government for consideration of the Letter of Permission, and the course will be started only after the issuance of the Letter of Permission from the Government.

(f) The institution shall furnish a Bank Guarantee of Rs. 5 lakh after getting the Letter of Permission.

(g) This No Objection Certificate will be valid for a period of two years from the date of issuance of the order.
