ORDER

Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for releasing an amount of Rs.4.5 crores as the first installment towards the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, Construction and Equipment for Up gradation and Strengthening of Emergency Facilities in Government Medical College & Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram (Level II) under the scheme "Capacity Building for Developing Trauma Care Facilities on National Highways" vide the G.O read as 1st paper above. As per G.O read as 3rd paper above Government accorded sanction for the release of Rs. 2,77,20,000/- (including central share of Rs. 1,66,32,000/- and state share of Rs. 1,10,88,000/-) and also accorded permission to transfer credit the amount to the Bank account for the scheme "Capacity Building for Developing Trauma Care Facilities in National Highways", Government Medical College Thiruvananthapuram.

2) As per the letter read as 4th paper above The Director, Medical Education has reported that administrative sanction for utilisation of funds have not been given vide the G.O read as 3rd paper above and hence it was requested to accord the same and to give permission to the

Principal, Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram for appointing employees on contract basis.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the utilization of Rs.2,77,20,000/- for the components, Communication, Legal Service and Data entry and Cost of Human Resource as detailed below, which was sanctioned vide the G.O read as 3rd paper above.


